Stage 2: Two days later a table of highest bids will be posted on the Members Area page of the Society's website. This will be repeatedly kept updated as further bids are sent in by email. Deadline: 14.00 hours GMT on Saturday, 17 April 2021.

Stage 3: For three hours after this time bidding is limited to increasing existing bids. Final closure: 17.00 hours GMT. Lots are awarded to the highest maximum bids.

Stage 4: Lots remaining unsold will be posted online, available for immediate sale.

During Stages 2 and 3, check that the online bidding table is including your bids.

If two bids of the same amount are received for a lot, then the bid received first takes precedence, so early bidding is desirable. Lots 1 to 240 are subject to reserves, either at the default value of 75% of the presale estimate or at a sum set by the seller (not exceeding the presale estimate). No bid will be accepted below the reserve, but you may, if you wish, send in bids at the 75% reserve (rounded up to the nearest pound). However, take into account that presale estimates are not a consistent guide to final price at auction, and may sometimes be greatly overbid. Lots 241 to 450, mostly single bookplates, are not listed here. Images and minimum start prices must be viewed online. Successful bidders were asked to pay for their lots before despatch. Purchases to a See write-up on p.4combined value over £20 are sent insured.

Nine lots sold above £50: Charles Dickens's crest bookplate, apparently from the second copper-plate, £185 (Lot 208, est £200); novelist John Galsworthy's scarce ex-libris, £85 (Lot 206, est £50); Keith Vaughan's unusual wood-engraving for Mervyn Evans Jones, £75 (Lot 210, est £85); Charles Goodspeed's Boston massacre, £70 (Lot 182, est £30); Oliver Wendell Holmes at £56 (Lot 202, est £25); American individuals, £55 each (Lots 158 & 196, est £15 & £20); SL Smith's self-portrait and George Washington's Chippendale (late version) also both sold for £55 (Lots 198 & 204, est £25 and £20). In the range of prices from £30 to £46 were 31 sales to a value of £1,151 (all above estimate £612). In the price range £10 to £29, 53 lots sold for £1,180 (above estimate £911) and 93 lots at £1,357 (below estimate £1,711). At the bottom end were 16 lots selling for £135 (est £180) with 31 lots unsold (est £552). The second half of the auction saw 111 lots

sold for £631 (minimum price £534) but 70 unsold (est £281). The auction and post-auction sale total of £5,145 was augmented by £76 from sale of duplicates.
