Please ensure you include your current address and contact details.

When two equal bids are received for a lot, it's the bid received first that wins, so early bidding is desirable. Reserves apply, either at the default value of 75% of the presale estimate or at a sum set by the seller (not exceeding the presale estimate). No bid is accepted below the reserve (rounded up to the nearest pound). Take into account that presale estimates are often greatly overbid, so not a consistent guide to final price at auction. Successful bidders are asked to pay for their lots before despatch. Purchases to a combined value over £20 are sent insured. Lots 501-650 are detailed online only.
