Bids by 21 April 2023; Results next day

Once again this is to be an online auction, rather than meeting in person, but at least this has the advantage of not being restricted by fixed meeting hours, so a greater quantity of material is offered. Bids by post/email must reach Peter McGowan by Friday, 20 April 2023. Mail postal bids to him at Nethergreen House, 9 The Green, Ruddington, Notts NG11 6DY or send an email to petermcgowan2016@gmail.com **with a copy to members@bookplatesociety.org**. He will confirm receipt of bids. Ensure you include your current address and contact details.

Do please assist us, if you can, by first listing each lot number and maximum bid in a 2-column table that you have prepared in Word (omit £ signs, punctuation and spaces) then copying this into your bidding email. It will enable these bids then to be passed directly, without retyping, into our auction spreadsheet which does all the work of checking what reserves apply and calculating the top bidder on each lot. When two equal bids are received for a lot, it's the bid received first that wins, so early bidding is desirable. Reserves apply, either at the default value of 75% of the presale estimate or at a sum set by the seller (not exceeding the presale estimate). No bid is accepted below the reserve (rounded up to the nearest pound). From Lot 445 onward the presale estimates are minimum prices (ie 100% reserve). Take into account that presale estimates are often greatly overbid, so not a consistent guide to final price at auction. Successful bidders are asked to pay for their lots before despatch. Purchases to a combined value over £20 are sent insured. Lots 455 onward are detailed online only.

For single ex-libris the number of items is no longer indicated. Taking listing space but barely saleable, these cannot be accepted into future auctions.
