
Successful bidders living outside the UK will be asked to pay for their lots before despatch.

REPORT ON AUCTION 73 HELD ON 4 OCTOBER 2014

The room saw some drama when two determined bidders fought for one of Ralph Sheldon's rare 17th century armorials (Lot 57). It sold expensively for £270, which seems to have pleased only the seller! Aubrey Beardsley's exlibris for Rainforth Armitage Walker and Mr Pollitt ran up hammer prices of £210 and £115. William Morris's printed label and five others in the Kelmscott Press style reached an unexpected £184, and John Buckland Wright's unsigned design for Lilian Beatrice Burtinshaw fetched £70, four times estimate. There were 103 lots exceeding their estimates (totalling £3,426, aggregate estimate £1,955), 19 lots sold on estimate (total £265) and bargains were found among the 57 lots that totalled £665 (estimate £1,021). Among this last group was Baron Craven's imposing large coronet and cypher was good value at £54 (versus £65 anticipated). Although 11 lots were unsold (estimate £197) these in large part found buyers after the auction. To our highest-ever auction total of £4,356 may be added a further £173 of sales of seven duplicate lots to underbidders. Of those present at the sale, nine spent £1,405 on 75 lots (estimate £1,371) but as usual the lion's share went to absentee bidders (total £2,951 for 104 lots, estimate £1,870).
